

FAQ	
How is the conveyor operated?	The conveyor comes with a dog lead remote. Control panels are easy to use and the machine comes with push lever valves with simple flow control.
Does the engine need DEF?	Yes, the CAT 3.6 98Kw/130HP Engine – requires Blue DEF
Does the conveyor have a tipping grid?	No, this is more for aggregate applications, not needed for mulch or compost
Are there any spray bars in the hoppers?	No, but these can be added as an optional extra. Please let us know if this is something that you require for your operation
What materials can this conveyor handle?	A flow gate is fitted so the machine is more versatile to be used on different applications such as aggregates or gravel. If you are going to process mulch or compost this panel is removed (6 bolts)
